Whereas by virtue of certain documents
issued by me the undersigned Anna Maria
Spark and Christiana Gindrup with her husband
Holger Gindrup under date the seventeenth day of this present month of September
in the year One thousand eight hundred and forty nine, all the right and title of
the said Anna Maria Spark and the said Anna Christiana Gindrup to one undiv-
ided half of the inheritance and Estate left in the province or territory of California by
William Alexander Seidesdorff son of the said Anna Maria Spark and brother of
the said Anna Christiana Gindrup, which said William Alexander Seidesdorff a
native of this Island died sometime in the year 1850, was transferred and conveyed
under certain conditions therein mentioned unto Joseph Libby Folsom, now the
undersigned Christian Muller being duly appointed and nominated by His Excell-
ency the Governor General of these Danish West India Islands the sole and lawful
guardian of Frederika Cordelia Seidesdorff, of St Thomas, a minor and daughter
of the deceased Frederick Laurentius Seidesdorff and his surviving widow Henrietta
Mathilda Seidesdorff do hereby further more and in like manner under the supposition
and full belief that the said Frederika Cordelia Seidesdorff is the legal heir to one
fourth of the whole of the said Estate, transfer and convey unto the said Joseph
Libby Folsom, Captain in the Army of the United States his heirs administrators
and assigns all the right and title whatever of the said Frederika Cordelia Seides-
dorff to the one fourth part of the said inheritance and Estate of the late William
Alexander Seidesdorff and I the undersigned Anna Maria Spark with the
consent of my undersigned curator Ludwig Heitruauu do hereby acknowledge
the transfer and conveyance to Joseph Libby Folsom made in this deed by the said
Christiana Muller of the right and title of the said Frederika Cordelia Seidesdorff
to be done with my knowledge and consent, and I furthermore declare that the sum
stipulated to be paid to the said Frederika Cordelia Seidesdorff is to be considered and
is hereby acknowledged to be a part payment of the sum of Thirty five thousand dollars
mentioned in the third article in the agreement signed and sealed in this Island on
the seventeenth day of this present month, and the condition of this transfer and con-
veyance being, that he the said Joseph Libby Folsom or his legal representative
over and above the sum of one thousand four hundred dollars already paid to me on
behalf of the said Frederika Cordelia Seidesdorff the receipt of which is hereby acknow-
ledged give his bond or bonds for \$17500, say seventeen thousand five hundred Dollars to
the said Frederika Cordelia Seidesdorff with good and undoubted sureties, bearing
interest at the rate of six percent per annum, in such manner as has been separately
stipulated and agreed upon now I do hereby as guardian to and in behalf of the said
Frederika Cordelia Seidesdorff declare and acknowledge, that as soon as for any such
person as shall be duly appointed to act in my place and stead, shall have signed in
due and legal form upon this document that the bond or bonds for \$17,500, in favor of

the said Frederika Cordelia Leidesdorff with the sureties, to the full and entire satisfaction of myself, or the person appointed to act in my stead have been delivered to me or the persons thus appointed to act in my stead, that from that time the conveyance and the transfer of all the right and title that the said Frederika Cordelia Leidesdorff has or may have under the full belief that I in behalf of the said minor, have the legal right thus to transfer and convey away one fourth of the whole of said estate or inheritance, but without any guarantee or responsibility on our part in that respect to one fourth part of the whole inheritance and estate left in the province or territory of California by the said William Alexander Leidesdorff unto the said Joseph Libby Folsom, his heirs administrators or assigns, is to be considered as finally consummated, and as soon as the said acknowledgement for the receipt of the Bonds with sureties as above mentioned shall have been written and signed upon this document as within stated, this present document shall become and serve as a pure and unconditional conveyance and transfer of the right and claim to one fourth part of the whole inheritance and estate left in California by the late William Alexander Leidesdorff as stated and described above.

In testimony whereof I the said Anna Maria Spark, not versed in the art of writing have hereunto affixed the sign of the cross, and I the said Ludwig Weitmänn, as also the said Christiana Muller have hereunto set our signatures and seals in the Danish Island of St Croix West Indies this 26th day of September in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and forty nine.
