

Info for Parent Chaperones

Thank you so much for signing up to help in your child's field trip(s) to Soil Born Farms. These experiences are not possible without your support. We value you for your time and energy in getting the kids to and from the farm safely and for helping to sustain a positive experience at Soil Born Farms and along the river!

- There are a few things you should keep in mind as you plan your visit to the farm:
- We are able to accommodate up to 8 adult chaperones. Logistically it is challenging if we have more than 8 adults.
- The experiences at the farm are adult participation experiences. Here at Soil Born we seek to foster positive youth-adult partnerships. This means that it is our hope that you will be working, learning, and teaching, alongside the youth you are chaperoning yet leaving space for youth to ask questions and try things on their own.
- All participants, including chaperones, are required to have a Soil Born Farms waiver on file. Your child's teacher will provide you with the waiver form.
- Please come prepared to get dirty and to actively engage in hands-on activities. We'll be working with the land and walking around the farm. Please dress appropriately: no open-toe shoes; and pants and a hat are highly recommended.
- Because your full attention is needed during the interaction, and because of liability issues, parents/guardians may not bring younger or older siblings on the field trips.
